Common courtesy call to your captain of the day

We are seeing a rash of last minute call in's, no show-no calls, and members who consistently run late to their duty tours without any notifications to the Captain of the Day. We would like to remind the membership that a call just to give the Captain a heads up would be appreciated as they would be able to help cover that portion of the tour.

For the last minute call in's, it would be common courtesy to give your Captain an ample amount of time to assist in finding coverage. You might be asking yourselves, "What is an ample amount of time?" We are asking that you give a minimum of SIX (6) hours notice. Most people know (in the working world) that they will be calling in within at least that amount of time whether they be sick or just need a mental health day. We feel that the same applies for the volunteer world. We understand that things happen, however, calling in 15-20 minutes after your tour does not help us. We can't even find paid coverage in that time, let alone volunteer coverage. Please have the common courtesy to help the organization.

As far as no show-no calls, we can advise that this is totally unacceptable and it is spoken about way to often in meetings.

Members are also reminded that if you have a regular duty slot and you can't make it, you are to contact the Captain and try to fill your spot. (as per the SOP's). You are responsible for your duty slot, regardless if you are a probationary member, dispatcher, EMT or Driver.

These situations apply to all members, probationary and badge, call-in to interim. When you commit to a slot or to help out someone, please do it. You are giving your word that you will help them out.

Ex-Chief Jason Hoffman: An Outstanding Member



Jason Hoffman has been a member at the Bay Shore Brightwaters Rescue Ambulance since the year of 1997. Jason first joined BSBRA as a Youth Squad when he was 14 years old. He has officially been an adult member for 16 years, making him a member for a total of 18 years. His position in BSBRA is being on the Board Of Directors. In his previous years at BSBRA, He was a captain for 2 years, the 2nd Assistant Chief for 2 years, the 1st Assistant Chief for a year and a half, and the Chief for 4 years. Jason decided to join the Board Of Directors because “[He has] goals and a vision for the department, and [He] felt that it would help the future.” One of Jason's goals is to get a new building for the department. The reason Jason started to get into working in EMS is because “[He] loved the thrill of helping people, and medicine was unique, and how you could save a life.”

A few things Jason would change about the department is the by laws that need to be upgraded. He also says that the leadership needs to be taken more seriously and trainings need to be attended by leaders. However something he would change about EMS in general would be the entire county's EMS infrastructure and how the closest ambulance to a call should be dispatched. Jason also rides on helicopters as a flight-medical when a patient is in critical condition and can't get to a hospital fast enough so they are air lifted. Jason said that he loves riding on the helicopters. He calls it a “fancy ambulance” that gets to places quicker with its high

speeds. He also says that, “Seeing Long Island from the air is amazing too, but [He] also gets to work with some of the best Police Officers in the county.” When Jason was offered the job to ride on the helicopters he was reluctant, but deep down he knew he wanted to do it so he did. Some of Jason's proudest moments at BSBRA was becoming chief and being able to watch members coming in as probies learning EMS and watching them succeed. He was also proud when he was Chief and he watch the department win awards in Local State and Nationals. But overall his favorite part about being a member in BSBRA is as he says, “The membership, and the aspects of working together on the road and how everyone is one big family. [He] met so many great people, and [He] enjoys working with everyone here in this department.”

The paramedic student candidate must pass a national standard written screening exam consisting of questions on basic math, reading comprehension and EMT knowledge prior to acceptance into the program.

All students are also required to complete a criminal background check and 10 panel drug screening conducted by an independent third party provider. The fee for this process is \$105.00 payable directly to the third party provider. Upon successfully passing all sections of the written screening exam and both components of the background screening a \$1000.00 non-refundable deposit will be required to hold your seat in the class, this will be deducted from your tuition upon enrollment in the program.
