As you all know we are in a transition period with some of the chiefs moving around in the chiefs office. We are going to try and minimize any interruptions in training schedules and keep the effect of the transition to a minimum. We ask that you please be patient with the chiefs office as we get comfortable in our new roles within the department. I will be working hand in hand with Shivannah who has done an amazing job keeping our members up to date on trainings and the new advances in EMS medicine over the last 4 years. Jim will still be conducting his normal CME trainings, the dates of those CME's will be posted on the website and in the newsletter calendar as done in the past.

If you have not taken the mandatory restraints training update your EMT privileges are suspended! We have given everyone ample opportunity to take this update by offering the class 6 times over three months! If you did take update at another department, please provide the chiefs with proof of such. This is a mandate set forth by Suffolk County REMAC (the governing body of EMS in Suffolk that allows EMT's, and ALS to practice in the county.) So this is not OPTIONAL!

We are looking for a few good men or woman who may be interested in the QA/QI committee. We need to go through almost a years worth of PCR's and must keep up with the paperwork and PCR's. If you are seriously interested please contact myself at [jhoffman@bsbra.org](mailto:jhoffman@bsbra.org) and we will coincide our schedules and come up with a date to meet.

I will also be working hand in hand to with the Probationary committee to ensure that our probationary members are getting the adequate training to perform their tasks and duties successfully at BSBRA. We are going to try and keep the meetings on a weekly basis. Once again please be patient during this transition. Please pay close attention to e-mails and the newsletter reports for updated information on the probationary committee. If anyone is interested in helping out on this committee please contact me via email.

The crew chief trainings will be given on a bi-monthly basis as long as their is interest. You can not become a crew chief if you have not taken this training! It is well worth it for all members to take this training as it teaches you many aspects of leadership and officer skills while on scenes, and dealing with off the wall situations. The dates for the crew chief trainings will be listed in the calendar as well.

My role with driver training will be minimal. As per the bylaws the driver training program falls under the 3rd assistant chief. I will be more then happy to assist in getting you trained as a driver. Please be patient with us as we take driving very seriously. Once again please ensure that you are using spotters whenever a dept owned vehicle is in reverse. We have had one too many accidents this year and we are trying to minimize these mishaps, as well it is an SOP and is there for your own safety.

Trainings-- I know that we all volunteer our time for the department and have lives outside of BSBRA, and it is completely understandable when you can not make a training here or there hence why our bylaws allow excuse forms to be submitted for trainings. I am going to try and put 4 months worth of training on the calendar so you will have plenty of notice as to when the trainings are, so try and re-arrange your schedule to attend the trainings as they will be posted 4 months in advance. I have been in contact with ER physicians both at SBUMC and SSH to come in and provide trainings for our department. So we will have some exciting new trainings in the future and ask that you please try and attend them as there are continually advances in EMS medicine and we want to do everything in our power to offer you the best trainings out there!

## **Board of Directors Policy Statement**

September 1, 2011

This duly approved policy statement is provided to inform the general membership of the following:

**As of September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011, no children under the age of 17 will be allowed within the building past 19:00 (7:00pm). This pertains to member and non-member children and includes youth squad members.**

This policy was generated to protect the organization as well as the child. Lately, there have been several instances of unsupervised children of members mistreating the pool table, walking on the couches, and touching the television. We have also had children disrupting the general meetings, running through the corridors, and attending corps functions late at night.

We realize that this will inconvenience some members; however we feel that it is in the best interest of the organization to not have these children in the building after 19:00pm.

The only exceptions to this policy are:

1. If the child is participating in a non-corps function as part of the room rental.
2. If the safety of the child is in jeopardy.
3. If the building is being used in conjunction with NYS "Safe Haven" law for abandoned children.

No Chief, Officer, or Director can grant general or occasional exception to this policy.

Failure to adhere to this policy can result in charges brought against the member.

In addition keeping the building clean at all times is a big one for me. You are all responsible for building cleanliness and I will be right there making this possible from taking out the trash to cleaning a bathroom if needed.

I will be working closely with the crew chiefs / senior members so that they can train and mentor our probationary members so that they can be an asset to BSBRA. In addition as a team we will work with the new EMT's in getting them through our clearance process and making them comfortable on calls.

Keep up the good work and remember be courteous to your patients and let's be professionals out there.

## Mondays

Thank you again to the membership for allowing me to serve another year in my role as captain. It is a great pleasure to be able to represent the greatest group of EMS providers around and I look forward to another very productive year.

One of the ongoing problems that we seem to be having is with fueling of the trucks. Since it is a part of your rig check, it is the responsibility of EVERY member of this department to make sure that the Ambulances are sufficiently fueled at all times. While the SOP's state that all corps vehicles are not to be below 1/2 tank, this doesn't mean that this is the only time that you can fuel them. The Bay Shore pumps on Second Avenue are open Monday through Friday from 0900-1500 (they are usually open until a little past 1500, but the closing times vary in my experience, so 1500 is a good rule of thumb). There is an additional fueling station in Central Islip off Carleton Avenue that is open during similar hours. If a vehicle needs to be fueled during off hours you can call Islip Public Safety at 631-224-5300 and they will open one of these locations for you. If you're not sure of how to get to either of these locations, contact any officer. The Bay Shore pumps being closed does NOT mean that the vehicles don't get fueled. By contacting Public Safety we have almost 24/7 access to fueling stations. While it may sometimes be an inconvenience to drive all the way to Central Islip, just imagine the inconvenience of running out of fuel on a job, or being that person who is in need of serious medical attention who has to wait because someone was too busy watching Jersey Shore to fuel an ambulance. If there are any issues with the fueling of ambulances please contact the Captain of the Day.

As I mentioned in Septembers General Meeting I am in need of help from 0600-1800 with crews. I've lost a ton of crew members due to different life experiences and I need a few good Men/Women to step up. I also have one TAC ambulance spot open every Monday, so if any EMT/Driver that wants to do that come on down. Laura Cincotta and Marlon Chavarria are the usual paid TAC staff and they're very easy to work with. If you want to come ride but have some other obstacle that I can assist you with that prevents you from coming down, please let me know and I will help anyway that I can. Also don't forget that I am a Driver Trainer and an FTO.

Lastly.....**RIG CHECKS!** Enough said.
